The City of Jackson, Missouri is currently accepting applications for the position of

WATER POLLUTION CONTROL FOREMAN

This position is the chief Wastewater Operator, responsible for DNR and EPA compliance of the City of Jackson Wastewater Treatment Plant. The Water Pollution Control Foreman supervises all operations and personnel of the Wastewater Department and reports directly to the Director of Public Works. As a working foreman, daily duties include but are not limited to maintenance and repairs of the wastewater plant and wastewater collection system, management of departmental budget expenditures, implementation of preventative maintenance plan, review of infrastructure development plans, inspection, and testing of new sewer main extensions. Communication with the public, design professionals, contractors, and other city departments and staff is also an integral part of the position.

A Missouri DNR Wastewater Operator Class B or higher certification is required, with at least five (5) years of wastewater operations experience, including hands-on experience in a wastewater treatment facility. The ability to read and understand construction plans, maps, and plats; and good communication, organization, and management skills are also needed.

The City offers a competitive starting salary with an excellent benefit package.
